Supplementary Academic Support (SAS) is an entitlement that all Australia Awards scholars can access during their scholarship period. SAS is available once a student commences and accrues at a rate of \$500 every six months (i.e. \$1000 a year) for the period of the scholarship. SAS funds cannot be accessed in advance. SAS can be used for individual tutoring, thesis editing for Higher Degree by Research (HDR) students and Masters by coursework students undertaking a dissertation or a research component. SAS can be used for training, workshops or conferences in accordance with the Policy Handbook. SAS applications must be approved by a Student Contact Officer in accordance with the Australia Awards Policy. SAS must be approved prior to the activity taking place.
